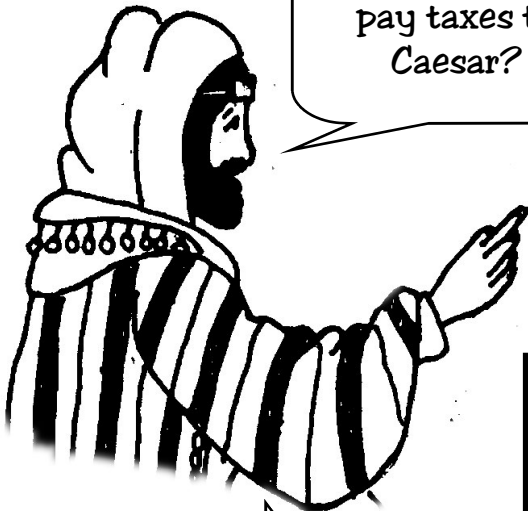


## WHAT CAN I GIVE TO GOD?
