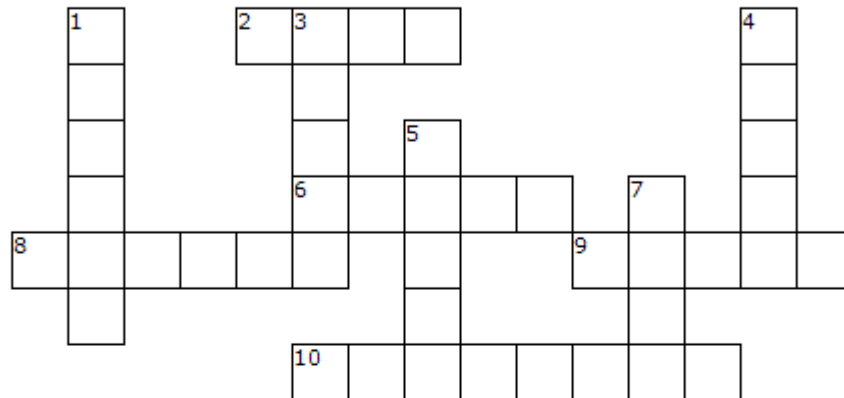

4. Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.



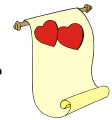
5. Honor thy father and thy mother.

7. Thou shalt not commit adultery.



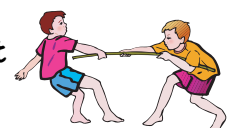

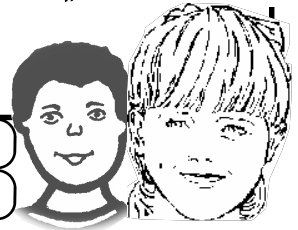
