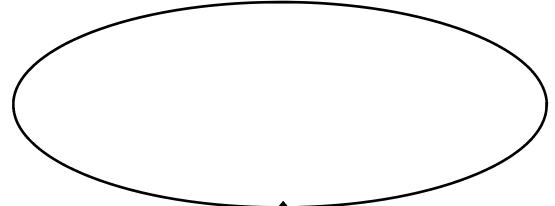
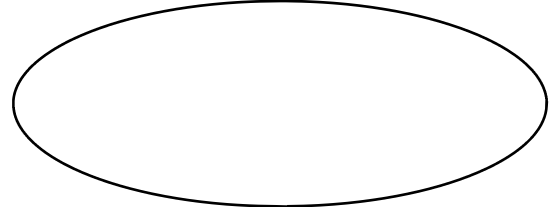
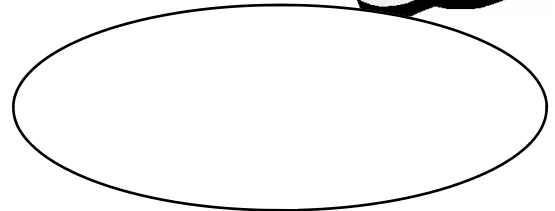


A man was going abroad.
