### REFLECTI

Today's Gospel has a particular focus on Jesus's physical post-Resurrection presence. The early Church was interested in making sure that its members knew Jesus was truly human not just "God in disguise." Jesus truly suffered, actually died, and really rose from the dead. Today's Gospel is a reflection of that

interest. Luke makes it clear that Jesus was physically present—he sat and ate with the disciples. But more than that, he stayed and taught them and explaine the Scriptures so that they could know in their heads and in their hearts that Jesus was truly risen!



# ACTION

When a new student comes to class there's a period of time where they're uncertain as to how things work. When the teacher makes a rule or request how strictly must it be followed? What are the expectations? The students who've been there all along will already know. The new kid won't. In today's Second Reading the idea is similar. Those who know God will keep his commandments. Do you know God? Do you know what God expects of you or are you the new kid? Practice the Two Great Commandments this week: love God, love your neighbor.
