

Liturgical Reflection...The Church celebrates the Paschal Mystery on the first day of the week, known as the Lord's Day or Sunday. This follows a tradition handed down from the Apostles and having its origin from the day of Christ's Resurrection. The fifty days from Easter Sunday to Pentecost are celebrated in joyful exultation as one feast day, or better as one "great Sunday." These above all others are the days for the singing of the Alleluia. Throughout the Sundays of Easter Time, it is obligatory to celebrate the Masses for Easter.
