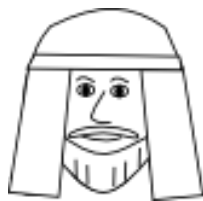
Twelve Disciples Coloring Activity

Jesus' disciples were twelve men he picked to travel with him and learn from him.

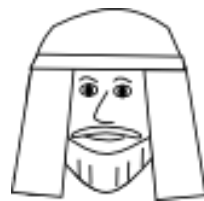
1. Color the twelve disciples and read their names.

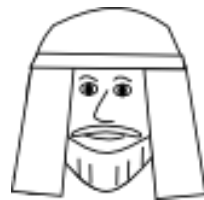

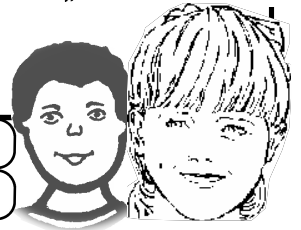

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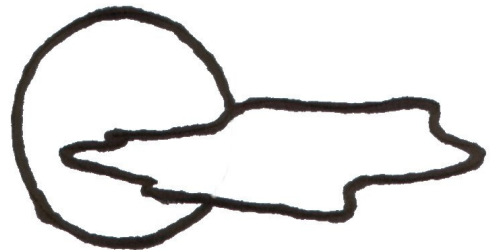
