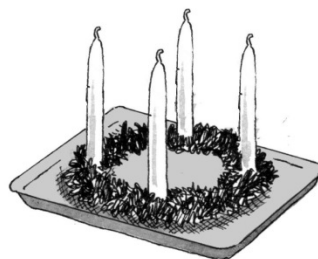

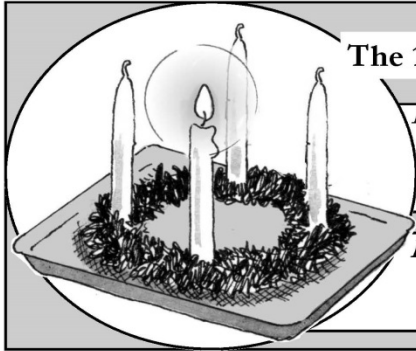
The Advent Wreath
