*Stewardship Reflection...* Good stewards, like the sensible bridesmaids in today's parable, are ready to share their gifts when the Master calls. The good steward is awake, alert to opportunities and actively *looks* for chances to make that difference.

It is the prudent use of our time, abilities, and finances that will always keep us mindful of the presence of the Risen Christ. But note: The good steward is a *conscious* steward, not a *guilty* steward. "Successful Catholic stewards are not hand-wringing worrywarts: 'Am I doing enough? Did I spend enough time there? Did I use my talents to the fullest? Am I as generous as I *should* be?'"
