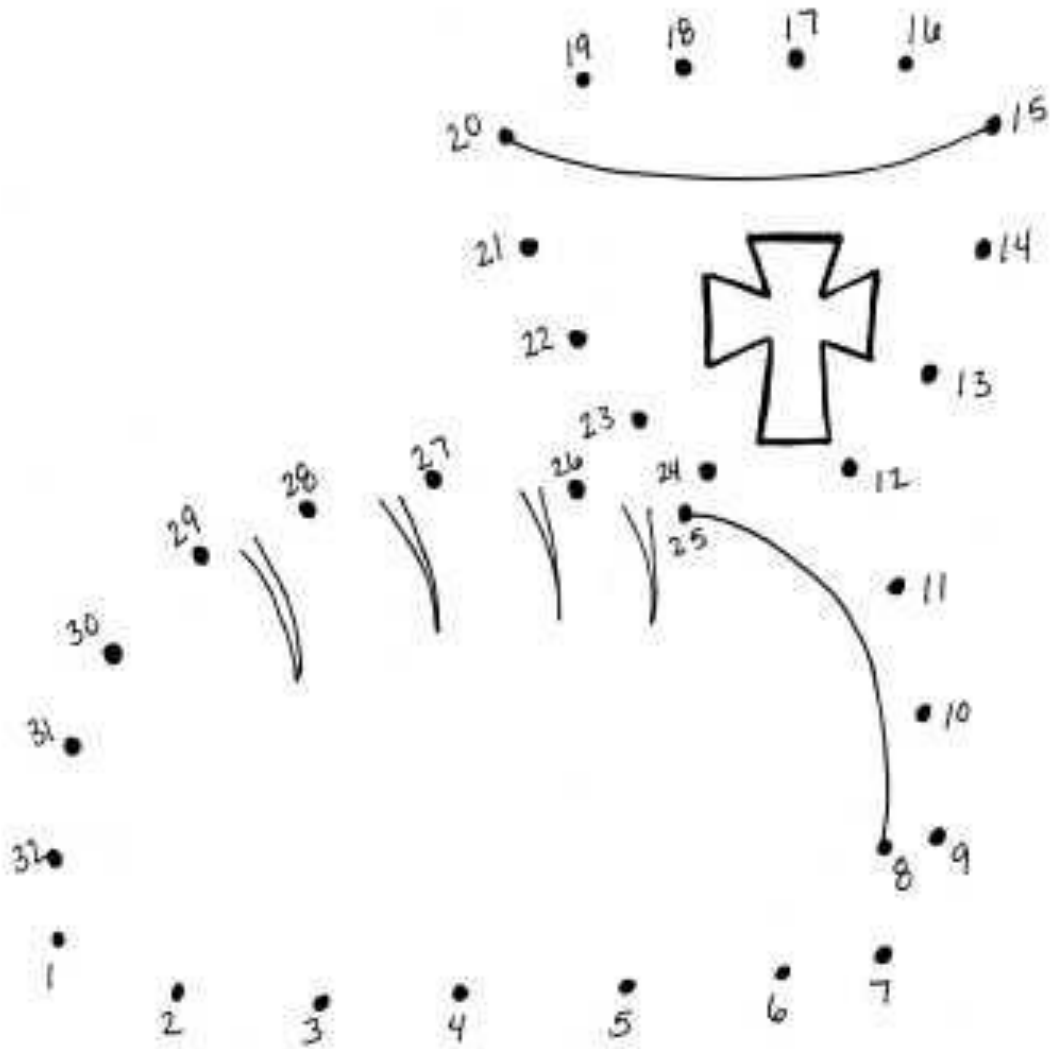
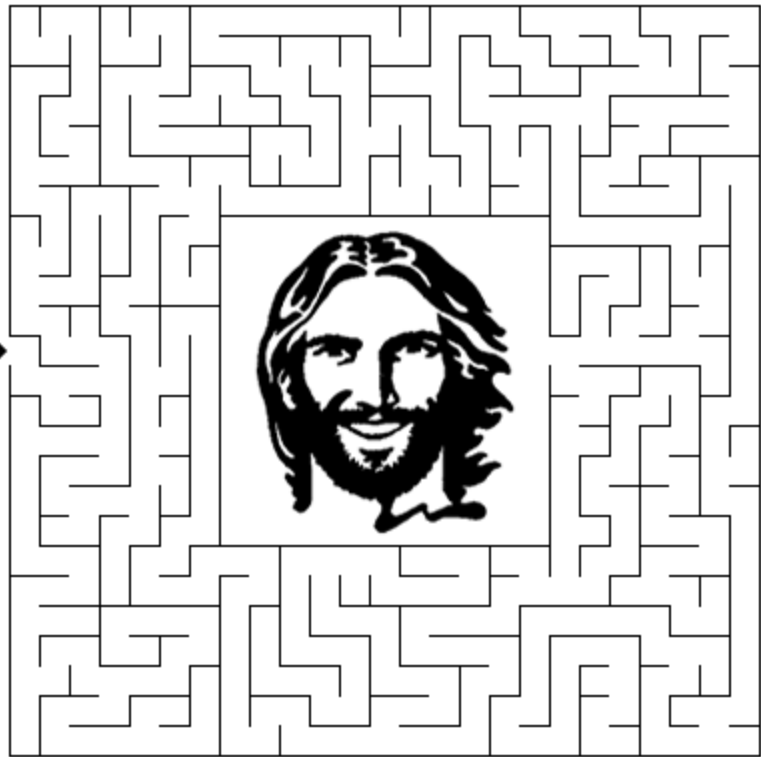
The path of circles below will lead you to the answer. Follow the correct path to the end and record all the letters in the spaces provided.

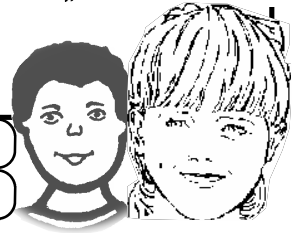
